Rules and Regulations and Waiver

Please read this information carefully. It includes releases of liability and waiver of legal rights and deprives you of the ability to sue certain parties. By checking the boxes and providing your name and the date, you acknowledge you've read and understood all of the text.

Rules and Regulations

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I have read and agree to the waiver

For everyone's safety and enjoyment, you must follow these rules and regulations, which the Forest Preserve District may change at any time.

- As the permit holder, you must be 21 or older and remain on-site with your permit for the duration of your stay.
- Do not bring alcoholic beverages into the forest preserve or campground; they are strictly prohibited.

I have read and agree to the Blackwell Family Campground rules and regulations.

- Arrive at the campground between 1 p.m. and 7 p.m. on the first reserved day and leave by noon on the last reserved day.
- Be in the campground when the gates lock one hour after sunset, and remain there until the forest preserve reopens one hour after sunrise the following morning.
- If you have guests, they can only be at the campground when the forest preserve is open (one hour after sunrise until one hour after sunset).
- Do not trench around tents, attach clotheslines or lanterns to trees, or otherwise disrupt the natural environment.
- Do not bring outside firewood or cut or collect live or dead wood. You can purchase firewood for \$7 a bundle at the campground office.
- Keep ground fires within designated fire rings. Extinguish fires and make sure they're cold to the touch before you leave your site.
- Keep your site clean and dispose of trash in the appropriate garbage or recycling containers. After you pack up, make sure your campsite looks as it did when you arrived.
- If you're using stereos or similar equipment, only do so between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m. and only at volumes that do not disturb other campers. Use gasoline or diesel engines or generators only during these times as well. Keep all noise to a minimum after 10 p.m.
- If you bring pets, stay with them at all times and do not tie them to any trees, plants, buildings or equipment. Always keep them leashed and guiet, and pick up any pet waste.

By checking the box below I agree to abide by these rules and regulations as well as all Forest Preserve District ordinances and administrative orders and state statutes. I understand that the Forest Preserve District may fine me or revoke my permit without refunding my permit fee if I supply false information on this application or fail to comply with any rules, regulations, ordinances, orders or statutes.
